- * Check gutters & downspouts for proper fastening.

- * Move shovel, snow blower, & salt to the front of your garage or basement for easy access.
- * Clean or replace furnace air filter for maximum efficiency.
- * Check batteries in smoke & carbon monoxide detectors.
- * Bring pots and planters inside, as they can swell and crack.

- * Check for drafts around windows & doors. Caulk as needed.
- * Adjust ceiling fans to the reverse or clockwise position to blow warm air down.
- * Clean, dry, & store patio furniture and garden hoses.
- * Secure outside steps and rails.
