Lorena Bankston celebrated her 100th birthday Wednesday April 13th with her family and friends at her home at 1890 Greenway South in Eastgate.

Lorena, sometimes referred to as Rena or Rene, remembers a time before electricity, riding a horse and buggy, and sleeping on straw mattresses for a bed. She grew up during a time that did not have indoor plumbing or television.

Rena was born in Dawson, Georgia to parents Will Hinton and Eliza Brown. The family moved to Ohio in the 1920s after her father was killed in WWI. Rena worked as a professional seamstress for a doll company and provided daycare for 35 years to children. She was the wife to Ezra Bankston, mother to three daughters, and has 10 grandchildren, 14 great-grandchildren and 4 great-great grandchildren. She has been a member of the St. Paul A.M.E. Church for over 80 years. She has lived in Eastgate for over 50 years and was presented with a gift from Eastgate Garden Civic Association and received congressional recognition from U.S. representative Joyce Beatty on the occasion of her 100th birthday.
